Averill, made payment for Lot 106, drawn by me, containing 195 acres, which at our drawing a small payment had been made on; but is, I believe now paid for; as there is no paper relative to it in De Kalb and (I think he says so) there is also another lot standing in his name on which a small payment fo \$300.00 (?) was made in 1807 viz 107 = 77 1/2 acres when you write to me do me the favor to inform me of the above I will endeavor to complete it and with your consent and assistance close the business of De Kalb between our respective families, a circumstance mutually satisfactory to us both with best respects and wishes for the health and happiness of all your family to whom be pleased to remember me,
