

De Kalb July 7th, 1808

My Dear Sir,

Since writing my letter to you of the 5th instant I have received payment in full of Black(Clark?) on the note of Peter Brown against him, left with me by you, amount \$130 50/100ths. He paid me the whole amount in silver, and as I have not on hand any bills and think it somewhat dangerous to send the money by mail I give you this early information, that you may devise some means to get the money with safety. Should any safe conveyance present itself, I will send it.
