

Lots, 355 to & 360. Excellent Land well watered 81  
Timber Maple Elm, Bass & beech

Lots, 361 to & 371. Handsome Land, no waste Land  
worth noticing, well watered by a large Creek, called  
Eln or Harrison Creek: the Creek offers in passing these  
Lots 5 or 6 mile falls, with handsome falls from 4 to  
15 feet, on Lots 366. 368 are the largest falls

Lots, 372 to & 383. Valuable Land save lot 377  
which is somewhat broken & Hemlocky, tho' the Lot  
boasts of an excellent mile seat offered by a considerable  
Creek watering most of the said Lots - Timber, Beech,  
Maple, Birch, Falls on the Lots 377. say 20 feet,  
called Tanners falls. -

Lots, 384 to & 390. Excellent Land, well watered  
Timber, Beech Maple Elm & Bass -

Lots, 391 to & 396. Superior quality Land, well  
watered by a small Run of water passing thro' the  
two of Lots, Timber, Elm, Bass Maple, the soil  
on high Land gravelly loam

Lots, 397 to & 408. The Land on these Lots are  
inferior to none in the County of St Lawrence, sufficiently  
watered by small Creeks & Springs, Timber, Maple  
a great proportion, denoting a good soil -

Lots, 309. to & 318. On Peoples Reservation so called  
contiguous to the Mills, these Lots, are miserably  
poor, sunken swamps or rocks covered with moss  
& small hemlock. No streams of water passing  
thro' them save 313. 318. watered by a small  
Creek passing & may be called better Land -
