

Special Town Meeting held  
pursuant to notice at the home of Asa  
L. Foster in the Village of DeKalb  
on Saturday February 27<sup>th</sup> 1864 the  
Following resolutions were passed

On Motion of Henry Thompson

Resolved that the board of town  
Auditors of the Town of DeKalb be  
and are hereby authorized to raise  
on the credit of said town the sum of  
Four Hundred dollars to be paid to  
Each Person who may be mustered  
into the Service of the United States  
and accredited to said town as a  
Volunteer therefrom or to any person  
who may be drafted and be duly  
mustered into said Service and  
accredited to said town under the  
Call of the President of the date of  
Feb 1<sup>st</sup> 1864 Provided no more money  
be thus raised by said board than  
will be necessary in the manner aforesaid  
to fill the quota of said town under  
said call

On Motion of S. W. Hemenway

Resolved that a committee of two be  
appointed by the Chair with authority  
to investigate and prosecute any person  
who may be engaged in enlisting persons  
from this town and passing them to the  
credit of other States. Contrary to law  
The Chair appointed S. W. Hemenway  
C. W. Lynde
