lutions were passed, and the following
Named Town Officers Elected

Resolution

Resolved that the unappropriated
Money in the hands of the Recruiting
Committee of this Town, or so much
thereof as may be necessary be applied
for the payment of the taxes of such
persons as enlisted in the Service of the
United States in or during the years
1861 or 1862, and actually served as
soldiers during the present War, until
they were honorably discharged therefrom
or have continued in said service by
reason of reenlistment or otherwise
and also for the payment of the taxes
of the Widows or Orphans of such
soldiers who have died in the service
Or that portion of such tax as shall
be the result of the vote of said town
by a Special Town Meeting held in
said town on the 25th day of January
1865, as said fund was assigned to
said town for that purpose, and
the residue of said money if any
be added to the common school fund
of said town
