I, Charles Rice born in DeKalb
in the State of New York aged Twenty four years
and by occupation a Farmer Do HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE to have agreed
with Cooper Brooks Esq. of Rupell
St Lawrence County New York

to become his SUBSTITUTE in the Military Service, for a sufficient consideration paid and delivered to me, on the Third day of September 1864; and having thus agreed with said Cooper Brooks, I DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE to have Enlisted this Third day of September 1864, to serve as a SOLDIER in the ARMY of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, for the period of Three YEARS unless sooner discharged by proper authority: I do also agree to accept such Bounty, Pay, Rations and Clothing as are, or may be, established by law for Soldiers. And I do solemnly swear, that I will bear true and faithful allegiance to the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles of War.

WE CERTIFY ON HONOR, That we have carefully examined the above-named Volunteer Substitute, agreeably to the Regulations, and that in our opinion, he is free from all bodily defects and mental infirmity which would in any way disqualify him from performing the duties of a soldier; that he was entirely sober when enlisted; that he is of lawful age, (not under 18 years;) and that in accepting him as duly qualified to perform the duties of an able-bodied Soldier, and as a Substitute in lieu of Cooper Brooks liable to be drafted in Rupell St Lawrence Co. in 17th Congressional District, N. Y. 1864, we have strictly observed the Regulations which govern in such cases. This soldier has Blue eyes Brown hair Fair complexion; is Five feet 7 inches high.
