July 7th 1806. Laid out a road from Capt. Farr's to town line towards Bally-beer road. From village to Farr's was laid out in Oct. 1805 by Salmon Rich & Kelsey Thurber - surveyers as follows - from the corner between Mr. Brown & Isaac Stacy near Hotel. S 28^o E 20 ch. S 47^o E 101 ch. to Capt. Farrs then South 60^o E 3 miles 56 ch. S 70^o E 77 ch. to town line.
