

Special Town Meeting  
 held pursuant to notice at the  
 of Asa P. Foster in the Town of  
 DeKalb on Wednesday August 17<sup>th</sup>  
 1864 the following resolutions were  
 passed

Resolution 1<sup>st</sup>

On Motion of S. L. Weston

Resolved that the board of Town au-  
 ditors of the town of DeKalb be and are  
 hereby authorized and required to issue  
 certificates of indebtedness in such deno-  
 mination as may be desired amounting  
 in the aggregate to the sum of Six Hundred  
 dollars to each person who has or may  
 enlist or furnish an acceptable sub-  
 stitute to apply on the quota of DeKalb  
 for the President's last call for 50000  
 Volunteers and that said certificates  
 be made payable one third on the  
 first day of March 1866 one third on  
 the first day of March 1867 and the bal-  
 ance on the first day of March 1868 with  
 interest annually

Resolution 2<sup>d</sup>

Resolved that if the Supervisors of the  
 County refuse to cooperate with the Town  
 of DeKalb in paying the \$300. County  
 bounty, then the above named officers  
 are hereby authorized and required to issue  
 bonds against the town of DeKalb for
